The paint was badly faded but still legible. On the east side it read, "Chew Mail Pouch Tobacco" and on the opposite, "See Rock City." Unique, but not quite what he had in mind. He turned down a well-worn gravel lane and drove for miles. Just when he thought success had eluded him, he topped a rise in the road and there it was - the most picturesque barn he'd ever laid eyes on. He slowed to a stop, grabbed his camera, and began taking pictures as he walked. The barn was round, resting on a slight rise in the barn lot. Though older than the See Rock City barn, this one had been well maintained through the years. On the peak of the barn's roof rested a quaint cupola, with a weather vane that squawked on its rusty post as it twisted in the breeze. He zoomed in on the weather vane, and that's when he spotted the faint outline of words.*
