ELDER NOMINATION PROCESS

Over the past few weeks we have been in a sermon series entitled: "Shepherds of the Flock". In this series we have looked at how the theme of shepherding is found all throughout the pages of the Bible. We have seen that God calls us all to be shepherds to others. And we have seen that shepherding is at the very heart of being an elder. Finally, this past week we looked at the qualities outlined in 1 Timothy 3:1-7 and Titus 1:6-9. We often refer to these as the "Elder Qualification Passages".

We have been using this series to prepare this church in moving forward with the process of installing new elders and reconfirming our existing elders. Sunday morning we announced the first step in this process. I want to repeat it here and give some clarification as this is very different from what we have done in the past. (The rest of the process will be unveiled this Sunday.)

(1 Timothy 3:1) says: "Here is a trustworthy saying: Whoever aspires to be an overseer desires a noble task." It is our belief that one of the qualifications of an elder is that he has the desire to serve in this role. He should not approach this reluctantly; but with humility, have the appropriate desire to be a servant leader in God's church. So, in order to show that desire, we are not accepting nominations for elders. Instead, if after much prayer and study, a man decides that it is his desire to serve as an elder in this church, we are asking him to submit his own name for consideration. The only names that we are accepting for consideration are those who submit their own names. This will apply to our current elders, as well. If they wish to continue to serve as an elder in this church, they must resubmit their name for consideration. Any man wishing to submit their name for consideration can let one of the current elders or myself know. The last day to submit your name is Sunday, June 23rd.

For everyone else that will not be submitting your own name, what can you do? We want to encourage everyone to be studying and praying about those men that you already see are shepherding, and that you think should be acknowledged as elders in this church. If you think that someone else is qualified and would like to see them considered as an elder, then we want to encourage you to go to that person and first — thank them for their service as a shepherd that they are already displaying themselves to be in your life and the life of others. Second — ask them and encourage them to consider submitting their own name for consideration as an elder.

I believe it is important that these men know that they have our support. So I am asking everyone to encourage these men that you believe should be elders in this church. Encourage those who are not currently elders to submit their name if you believe they should do so. Encourage our current elders to resubmit their names. Even if you know that any of these men are already planning to submit their name or have already been approached by somebody else, encourage them anyway. The role of an elder in the church is not an easy one; and there is no limit to the amount of encouragement they could use. As the sheep under their care, let's encourage them now; and let's continue to encourage them in the future.
