This past weekend we enjoyed a very successful Vacation Bible School. We want to say, "Thank you" to everyone who played a part in making this time a success. Adults and children alike had a good time and learned more about what it means to stand up, like superheroes, for Christ.

Several times over the past few weeks we have talked about this passage (Matthew 18:3) where Jesus says, "Truly, I say to you, unless you turn and become like children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven." Isn't it fascinating that God would call us to become like children! I would like to challenge us all to build off of our time at VBS, learn from our children, and find ways to practice a child-like faith.

To help us with this challenge, I thought I would share some steps to becoming like children that I found. These were suggested by Russell E. Spray.

1. **Practice Humility** – "Whoever humbles himself like this child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven." (Matthew 18:4)
2. **Practice Trust** – "Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding." (Proverbs 3:5)
3. **Practice Light-heartedness** – "...casting all your anxieties on him, because he cares for you." (1 Peter 5:7)
4. **Practice Persistence** – "Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for he who promised is faithful." (Hebrews 10:23)
5. **Practice Anticipation** – "I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus." (Philippians 3:14)

I hope that we all can learn to put all of these child-like characteristics into practice in our own spiritual lives. Thank you again to all who helped with, attended, and supported VBS!

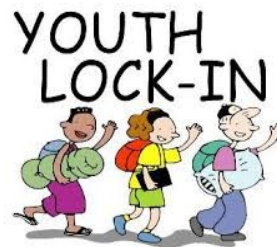
