Disciples of Jesus

Last week I attended the New Day Conference at the North Boulevard Church of Christ in Murfreesboro, Tennessee. It was a very powerful event that stressed the importance of churches and Christians living out the mission of God to, "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations..." (Matthew 28:19a). We are to be disciples of Christ that are making disciples of Christ. There were several very good speakers at this event. They all took a different approach to this main theme of discipleship. The final keynote speaker, David Young (Senior Minister — North Boulevard Church of Christ), stressed the difference between being a disciple of Christ and being a church member. His point was that we need to be more than members of a church; rather, we are to be disciples of Jesus. Dr. Young shared the following chart in helping us to notice the difference between the two:

Church Members	<u>Disciples</u>
Go to church.	Are the church.
Talk about Jesus.	Follow Jesus.
Have a religion about God.	Have a relationship with God.
Pray for what <i>they</i> want.	Pray for what <i>God</i> wants.
Confess that they "make Mistakes."	Confess their sins to each other.
Have doctrines about music.	Sing.
Believe in going to church.	Bring others to Christ.
Listen to and critique sermons.	Are living sermons.
Know facts, doctrines, and rituals.	Know God Intimately.


