We are thankful for their dedication to prayer meetings, and hope to follow in their very BIG footsteps by continuing to offer a time of focused group prayer for our church, family and friends. The next meeting is planned for Tuesday, November 5<sup>th</sup>, at 6:00 pm in room 17. Please arrive early for dessert, coffee, and time to chat. Kids are welcome! We will include them as much as possible. We won't always be able to meet on the first Tuesday of the month, so please pay attention to potential date/time changes.

For the foreseeable future, we plan to explore the prayer(s) of a different bible character at each monthly prayer meeting. By using his or her prayer, and the example of God's intervention in his or her life, our prayers can be enriched. Our hope is to be mutually encouraged by biblical examples and especially by each other's prayers and requests.

The first example we will explore is the brief prayer of Hagar in Genesis 13:13 where she says, "You are the God who sees me." and "I have now seen the one who sees me." God's intervention in Hagar's life is described in Genesis 21:14-20. The highlight of this passage is in verse 19... "God opened her eyes and she saw a well of water."

Our prayer time November 5<sup>th</sup> will center on the experience of Hagar in the wilderness and the blessed provision of God. The following are some questions to consider as we attempt to apply the experience of Hagar to our lives: What aspect of God's nature has been confirmed in your life? How has He provided for you? Are you currently in a wilderness of sorts? In what way(s) do you need for God to "open your eyes" and "provide a well of water"? Let us come together in prayer and expect the God who saw Hagar to see us as well.
