## Testifying Faith

*As Jesus was on his way, the crowds almost crushed him. And a woman was there who had been subject to bleeding for twelve years, but no one could heal her. She came up behind him and touched the edge of his cloak, and immediately her bleeding stopped.*

*“Who touched me?” Jesus asked.*

*When they all denied it, Peter said, “Master, the people are crowding and pressing against you.”*

*But Jesus said, “Someone touched me; I know that power has gone out from me.”*

*Then the woman, seeing that she could not go unnoticed, came trembling and fell at his feet. In the presence of all the people, she told why she had touched him and how she had been instantly healed. Then he said to her, “Daughter, your faith has healed you. Go in peace.”*

*- (Luke 8:42b-48 NIV)*

For the past few months we have been studying the Gospel of Luke in the Sunday morning auditorium class. Each week we are encountering broken people that Jesus is making whole. This story is no different. A woman who had been unclean for twelve years is now healed. But Jesus did not just heal this woman. He required something in return. He required her to proclaim her great faith.

In the same way, God does great things in our own lives. He takes our broken lives and makes us whole. Our response, as terrifying as it may be, should be to proclaim our faith in him.

Darrell L. Bock wrote, “The testimony of the previously timid woman is also instructive. She is asked to testify to an embarrassing situation and how God had healed it. Not only was it unusual for a woman to speak in public in this culture, but the nature of her problem made it even more difficult. Yet when Jesus called for her to step forward, she spoke. The test is clear that she ‘came trembling’ as she did so. It can be frightening to speak up for the Lord sometimes, but this woman found the strength by God’s grace to overcome her fears and to tell the story of what Jesus had done for her. A timid faith can become a testifying faith. God longs for us to share how he has been good to us.” (LUKE: The NIV Application Commentary)

God has been good to us! Let’s step out in faith and proclaim his greatness!
