**BUILDING FUND UPDATE**

Thank you so much to all who have donated to the building fund! Because of you, we now have a freshly paved parking lot that not only looks great, but is much safer. To date, we have raised \$31,712.10 in the building fund. The total cost of the parking lot pavement was \$32,455.75. That completes Phase 1.

Phase 2 of the building fund will include the following improvements and updates: replacement of windows on front of building (this will require some ductwork and possibly a heat pump on the roof for the offices), replacement of all three metal doors on the rear of building, complete roof replacement on gymnasium, and the replacement of the kitchen windows. In all, this will require about \$30,000. If you are able, please continue to donate to the building fund. Your help and support are greatly appreciated!
