GOD'S CHILDREN

Recently I was re-reading a book that I have made reference to on several occasions. It is Dr. Harold Shank's, <u>Children Mean the World to God</u>. The chapter I was reading is entitled, "God's Answer for Helplessness". Just the title of this chapter has encouraged me to return to a right mindset in light of all that is happening around us.

There are currently many hot-button issues in the news; and at the core of seemingly all of them, are hurting children. We have seen in the news hundreds of young girls tell their story of a trusted doctor sexually abusing them. We have seen multiple school shootings that have led to the deaths of several children and injury of many more. Many children have been physically hurt; and so many more have been mentally, emotionally, and spiritually wounded. Even in our own state, we have state employees and government locked in a stalemate over fair pay, benefits, and treatment of state employees. Even with this issue, no matter with which side you might agree, the unfortunate truth is that children are coming out on the losing end.

With all of these issues, and so many more, I am constantly asking, "What is the answer? What can we do? What's the solution?" There are countless opinions on all of these as to what laws need to be put into place or what practices need to be implemented. But, will any of these fix the problem?

Maybe it is time we shift our focus. We have our own answers for the helplessness; but what is God's answer? The truth is - our laws and practices might alleviate the symptoms; but God calls His church to help cure the disease. Consider this excerpt from Dr. Shank's book:

"Different institutions make up our society. Government makes laws against hurting children. Education provides materials to train us to live together in harmony. Industry makes products to protect children. Medicine finds ways to repair the damage violence does to children.

None of those institutions deal with the real issue. Governments pass laws, but they cannot change hearts. Education provides insight, but it can't remake the soul. Industry offers a better product, but it will not change character. Medicine repairs the physical heart, but it cannot repair the spiritual heart. Only one institution in society is charged with telling people about sin and the cross. Only one institution in society is prepared to deal with the fundamental issues causing violence to children. Only the church can point the way to change human hearts."

Just prior to this excerpt, Dr. Shank says: "The church is not a place to isolate us from the cries of hurting children, but a center from which God sends out rescue teams." Well, it is time for God's rescue team to deploy. It is time for the church to stand up and protect God's children. It is time for the church to stop passing out bandaids and start administering the cure. It is time for the church to show a world of broken children that they can be made whole in Jesus. It is time for the church to preach a message of the awfulness of sin and the need for confession, repentance, forgiveness, and grace.

"Religion that God our Father accepts as pure and faultless is this: to look after orphans and widows in their distress and to keep oneself from being polluted by the world." - (James 1:27)

"He has delivered us from the domain of darkness and transferred us to the kingdom of his beloved Son, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins." - (Colossians 1:13-14)

"And there is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved." - (Acts 4:12)

It is time for the world to know that the solution is not in man-made laws and practices. The solution is in God-given mercy and grace!
