BLESSED IN DOING

We are moving right along! If you are staying on track with our Bible reading project, then you would have finished the book of Exodus yesterday and started Leviticus today! I hope you are enjoying the journey! In fact, as we wrap up the first month, I would ask that you stop me and let me know your honest thoughts on what we are doing. Your feedback is very important.

I want to take a moment to encourage you if you are a little bit behind. It's not too late to catch back up or even start if you haven't yet. The extra work to catch up and join the journey will be well worth it! I also want to remind all of us that this is not about accomplishing the reading, rather it is training towards godliness. "Rather train yourself for godliness; for while bodily training is of some value, godliness is of value in every way, as it holds promise for the present life and also for the life to come." - (1 Timothy 4:7b-8)

Training can be done in many different ways. In order to graduate with my Bible degree, I had to do two types of training. One was in class study. It was studying the Bible, reading books by Christian authors, listening to lectures, writing papers, etc. This type of training was and continues to be very valuable.

The other training was on the job training. We had to do a practicum/internship in order to graduate. This was 10 weeks of full time work with a church. I was to shadow the preacher and work in every way a preacher would normally work. As you may know, there are some things that cannot be fully understood just by study; you really need the first hand experience. However, the first hand experience would be incomplete without the study.

In our Bible readings, it is important that we study and practice. It is important that we are responding to and doing what we are reading. God calls us to see what He is doing, then to imitate His example. We are training ourselves to be godly (or God-like).

James said it this way, "But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves. For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man who looks intently at his natural face in a mirror. For he looks at himself and goes away and at once forgets what he was like. But the one who looks into the perfect law, the law of liberty, and perseveres, being no hearer who forgets but a doer who acts, he will be blessed in his doing." - (James 1:22-25)

My prayer is that we are enjoying our time studying God's Word. It is also my prayer, though, that we are completing our training by being "doers who act". God's promise is that we will be "blessed in [our] doing."
