#### **TREASURES**

I love those who love me, and those who seek me diligently find me. Riches and honor are with me, enduring wealth and righteousness. My fruit is better than gold, even fine gold, and my yield than choice silver. I walk in the way of righteousness, in the paths of justice, granting an inheritance to those who love me, and filling their treasures. (Proverbs 8:17-21)

Take a moment and consider all of the material things we pursue in this life. We aim high. We aim for the bigger houses, nicer cars, extravagant vacations, inflated bank accounts. We measure success in someone by their net worth. We work hard in order to gain riches. But, what if there was something better? What if there were more to life than just pursuing the material things?

In the above passage, the author is writing from the viewpoint of wisdom. This is not a worldly wisdom; rather, this is wisdom given by God. This wisdom speaks of how it will return love to those that love it and seek diligently for it. Then, it makes this wonderful promise of the things for which we are all searching... riches, honor, and wealth!

The secret to happiness and fulfillment in this life... everything we have ever wanted - the bigger houses, nicer cars, extravagant vacations, and the inflated bank accounts - can all be found in the pursuit of Godly wisdom, right? After all, that is what all of these "prosperity gospel" preachers are teaching.

There is partial truth in the above paragraph. The secret to happiness and fulfillment in this life IS found in the pursuit of Godly wisdom. However, that same Godly wisdom will teach us that the things that bring happiness and fulfillment are NOT the things we always expected.

The author goes on to speak of riches, honor, wealth, gold, silver, inheritance, and treasures. These are the things we want in life! However, the result or "fruit" of wisdom is even better! (Proverbs 8:19) says, "My fruit is BETTER than gold, even fine gold, and my yield than choice silver." The author states that love, riches, honor, wealth, righteousness, justice, inheritance, and treasures will all be found by those that diligently seek wisdom! However, that wealth and fulfillment will not look like the things that we have always expected. It will be even BETTER!

What could be better than wealth, mansions, luxury cars, extravagant vacations, and unparalleled net worth? All of these things provide momentary pleasures, but eventually they will all succumb to rot and decay. They cannot provide fulfillment, because they will eventually go away. Godly wisdom offers something better in that it offers treasures that will not pass away. What is that treasure?

"For whoever finds me finds life and obtains favor from the LORD." - (Proverbs 8:35)

Material things are nice, but they are only for a moment. Ultimately, all that is found in material wealth is death. Godly wisdom provides something greater! Godly wisdom leads all who find it to eternal life and favor - eternal love, riches, honor, wealth, righteousness, justice, inheritance, and treasures - from the LORD!

My prayer is that we will all pursue wisdom and find our value, our life, our happiness and fulfillment, and our favor in God!
