If you are anything like me, it may be kind of difficult to understand all that is going on in the book of Isaiah. All of the imagery, poetry, and prophecy can get pretty confusing at times. Here is a list of themes that I like to reference to help keep my study focused. I have compiled this list from some introductory readings of Isaiah. I hope it can be as helpful to you as it has been to me.

- (1:4) - God is the Holy One of Israel
- (2:2-4) - Exclusive worship is due God
- (6:7) - God's cleansing touch atones for sin
- (9:12,17,21;10:4) - God's wrath is fierce
- (12:3) - God's salvation flows in endless supply
- (13:1-27:13) - God is the Sovereign over the whole world
- (30:15) - To rest in the promises of this God is his people's only strength
- (43:3-7) - God is moving history toward the blessing of his people
- (43:10-13) - God is the only Savior.
- (45:22-25) - Isaiah defines everything else by its relation to God, whether it is rightly adjusted to him as the gloriously central figure in all of reality.
- (48:11) - CENTRAL THEME - God himself, who does all things for his own sake.
- (49:26) - The whole world will know that God is the only Savior.
- (52:7) - God's gospel is "good news of happiness"
- (55:1-2) - To delight themselves [God's people] in God's word is their refreshing feast.
- (57:15) - God is the One who is high and lifted up but who also dwells among the "contrite and lowly"
- (62:1-12) - To serve God's cause is [God's people's] worthy devotion
- (66:24) - To rebel against God is endless death

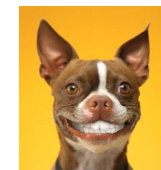
