## TELL SOMEONE

There's a popular song in Christian music right now called, "Somebody Tell Them" by City Harbor. This song came on the radio as I was driving into work this morning. Though I have heard it many times, I guess this was the first time I really paid attention to words. It is a song that addresses the hurt that so many people find in this world. Then, the chorus offers a simple message of hope. This is what the chorus says:

*Somebody tell them that the lost are saved  
Somebody tell them that their debt's been paid  
And let them know love is calling out their names  
Somebody tell them, they're the child of the king  
And there is an end to this suffering  
And hope that never fades through grace that's made a way.*
