CHURCH BUILDING SAFETY

Dear church family:

On Saturday, October 8th, our building was broken into and some items were stolen. We received notification that the church van was missing from the lot Saturday evening. Tom Hannigan and Chris Morris came down to check things out. They knew right away that someone had been in the building and immediately called the Charleston police. The police walked the entire building, inside and out. We then took inventory of the items that were missing. It appears that 3 televisions, the church van, some coins that had been collected for Potter's Children's home, the church laptop from the office, food from the pantry collection cabinet, and bus passes were stolen. The church van was located and recovered down the road on Chesterfield Avenue and it had one of the televisions in it. Thankfully, no damage was done to the building and no one was hurt.

We are working with the police to provide them with any leads, and with the insurance company to seek reimbursement for the stolen goods.

Safety is a top priority for our members and our employees. Please rest assured that we are going to work to make sure our building is safe and protected going forward. The elders will be meeting this week to discuss further details and we will certainly keep everyone informed of the progress.

We also ask that you do your part to help keep our building safe. For example: if you are the last to leave, make sure the door is locked; if you open a window, be sure to close and lock it back; if you are a teacher, please lock classroom doors after class. We will also be keeping the church office door closed and locked when church is not in service, however if you need in, all elders have a key. The copier and paper have been moved to the printing room beside the teen classroom for your convenience. Anything you can do to help is appreciated. If you have any questions, comments, or concerns please don't hesitate to let us know.
