JESUS LOVES MOMMY

A couple of weeks ago, I was playing with my daughter, Macy. At one point, she grabbed my hand and started looking at it. That's when she pointed to my wedding ring and asked, "What's that?" Already, her curious little mind had realized that Daddy had something on his finger that she didn't have on hers. I told her it was my wedding ring, but immediately knew that this explanation simply was not enough for her.

As she looked more intently at the ring, I said, "Do you know what it means?" She responded, "What?" I said, "That's Daddy's wedding ring. It means that Daddy loves Mommy!"

He who loves his wife loves himself. For no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as Christ does the church, because we are members of his body. Spouses, are you loving one another in a way that your partner knows, that not only do you love them, but they are also loved by Jesus? If not, then you are doing it wrong. Parents, when your children see your interactions with each other, do they know, that not only do you love each other, but you both also love Jesus and are loved by Jesus? If not, then you are doing it wrong.

Marriage is a sacred covenant between husband, wife, and God. So yes, my wedding ring means that, "Daddy loves Mommy!" Macy also reminded me of another great truth of the greater love I should always show in my marriage. My wedding ring means, "Jesus loves Mommy!" Love one another in the same sacrificial way that Jesus loves each one of us!
