Come to grow and enjoy fellowship with other men!

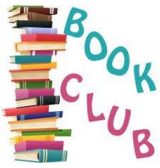

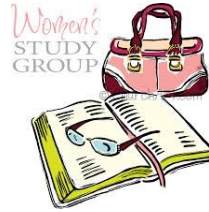
