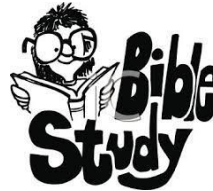


**MEN AT THE CROSS**

## LADIES' BIBLE CLASS



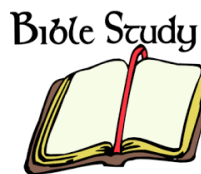
The Ladies' Bible Class meets on **Wednesday nights** from **6:30 pm-7:30 pm** in room 17.

String-type backpacks for school age children — 100 to 200. Supplies for back packs for 100 to 200 (pencils, markers, pens, notebooks, packaged snacks)

Books and Concordances for children of all ages

Hymnals in English (new or used)

Games for all ages

Hair bows for all ages

Reading glasses

Packages of socks for all ages — adult and children's

Shoes and sandals (all sizes — new or used)

Baptism garments

Communion trays (new or used)

Large amount of packaged snacks for many families

Blood pressure machines and batteries for those machines

Glucometers

Hand sanitizer

Crochet hooks and yarn for many women

Baby blankets, baby receiving blankets (made or purchased)

Birthing Kits (blanket, onesies, baby cap, 2 chucks pads, umbilical clamp)

Baby plastic pants

Baby shirts of all sizes

Soft wash cloths for babies and small bars of Ivory soap
