The Ladies' Bible Class meets on **Wednesday nights** from **6:30 pm - 7:30 pm** in room 17.

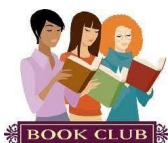
The class has finished the *Every Good Gift* study. We will be taking a break this Wednesday: **July 12**.
