On **October 29**, we will **Connect For Fun**, with our annual Trunk-or-Treat celebration! Please come and bring a friend! More details to come!

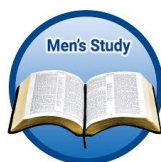
## SUNDAY MORNING ADULT BIBLE CLASS
