The Sunday Morning Adult Bible Class meets at **9:30 am** and is studying the parables of Jesus. The class is led by **Matt Gallagher**.

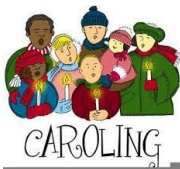

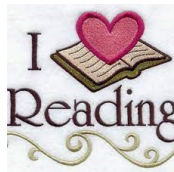
