You have magnified the Love of God in His kingdom.

[Various disasters recently hit Malawi and have] *hindered church attendance and volunteer work. Your help has made the words spoken by our Savior, Jesus Christ clearer now than before. When you first obey the gospel other things shall be given to you as well (Mat 6). You have put the light on the stand for people to see and also to engage in a divine ministry of taking care of, Jesus by helping those in need (Mat 13 & 24). Weekly attendance is increasing and many people are obeying the gospel.*
