WEDNESDAY LADIES' BIBLE CLASS



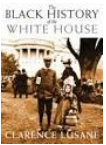
The Ladies' Bible Class meets on **Wednesday** nights from **6:00 pm - 7:00 pm** in room 17.

LADIES' BOOK CLUB

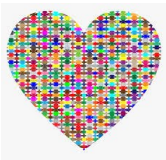


The Book Club's next meeting will be on **Tuesday, May 28**, at **6:00 pm** at Panera Bread, South Ridge, South Charleston.
