## MEN'S BIBLE CLASS

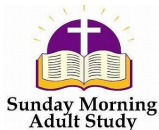


The Men's Bible Class meets at the church building on **Wednesday** nights from **6:00 pm - 7:00 pm**. The men are discussing the book of *1 John*.

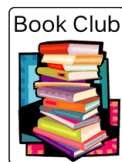
