This year we will again be participating in the **Caring & Sharing Project for Malawi, Africa**, sponsored by the Pine Grove Church of Christ and in conjunction with other local area churches. We took part in 2023 and received much-welcomed donations of items & cash which were transported to the very poor country of Malawi and **greatly appreciated**. See the next page for more details and what items are needed. **All donations need to be at the building by June 8, 2025**, to start their very long journey to Africa where they will arrive in Malawi around the middle of December.

Accomplished in 2024


- 12 congregations in the area participated
- 133 boxes of materials were collected – having an estimated value in excess of \$40,000
- Delivery logistics were altered in response to hostilities that closed the Suez Canal
- 12 sets of tools provided to apprentice programs
- \$5,250 (US) was provided for purchase of food and support for local preachers
- 200 women received birthing kits
- Countless children clothed

The Need Continues

- Despite server hardship, churches in the region surrounding Tombolombo continue to grow in number and in service to the people.
- Last year's drought continues to impact food supply-30% of families go entire days without meals.
- This year's harvest expected to begin in April will be smaller than needed to resolve the problem.
- The work skills apprentice program had 30 applicants, but the church could only fund 18.

Your brothers and sisters in Malawi thank you for caring.

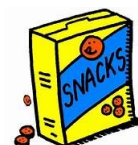
