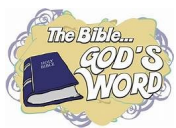

LADIES' BOOK CLUB



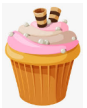
The book club's next meeting will be on **July 22, 6:00 pm**, at Panera Bread, So. Ridge, So. Charleston.
