MEN'S BIBLE CLASS

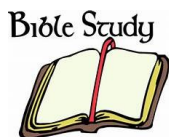

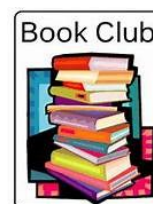
LADIES' BOOK CLUB
